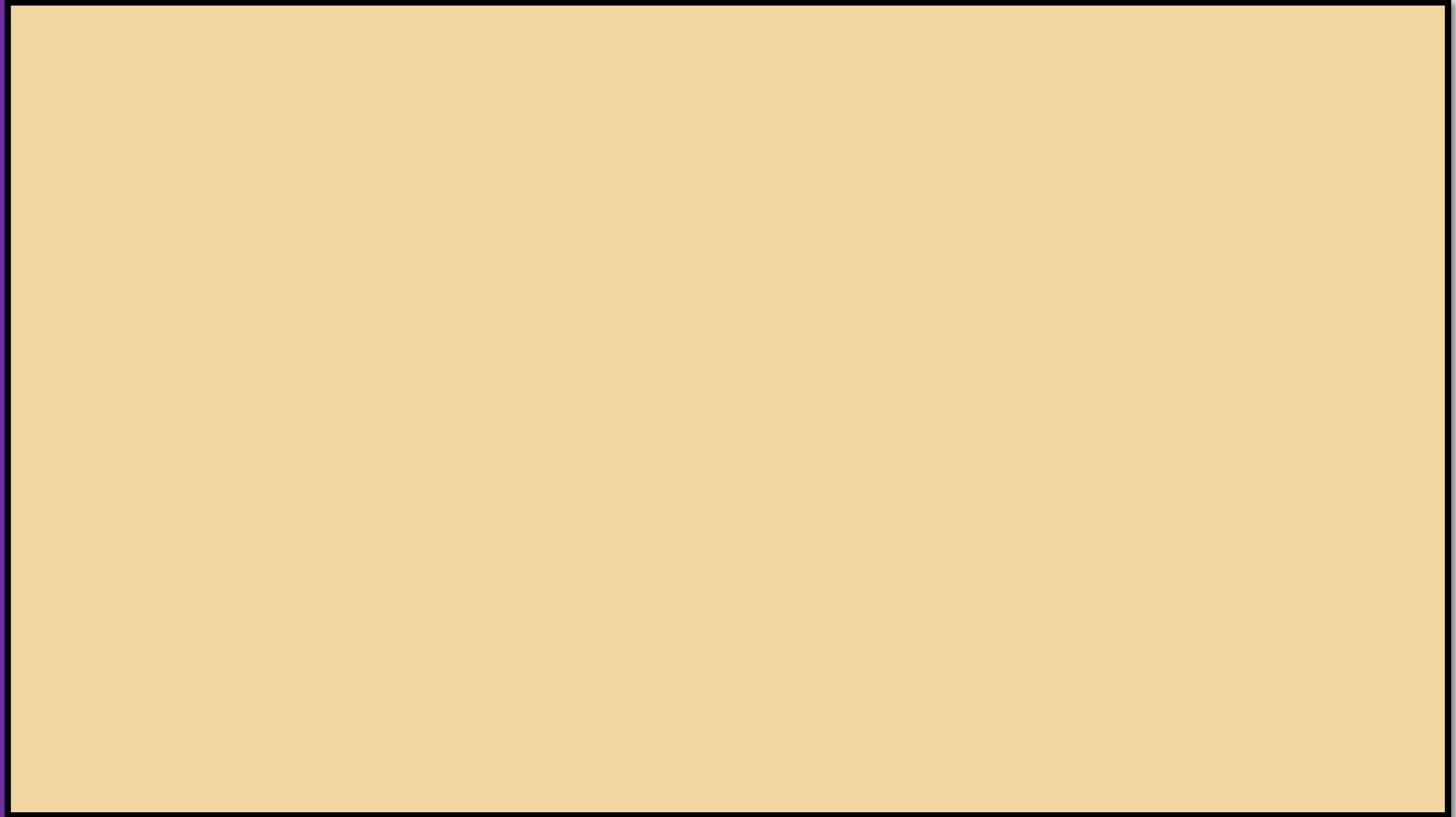

WHEN TO USE?

Use the simple present for actions happen regularly, rarely, sometimes, always, often, never, etc.

Also, for the following:

- **General truths:** Earth revolves around the sun.
- **Habits:** I brush my teeth twice a day.
- **Scheduled events:** The train leaves at noon.






SENTENCE STRUCTURE

Subject + Verb (base form) + Object

I	run	in the morning
You	eat	Pizza
We	make	cars
They	type	documents
He	teaches	lessons
She	drinks	tea
It	moves	its tail

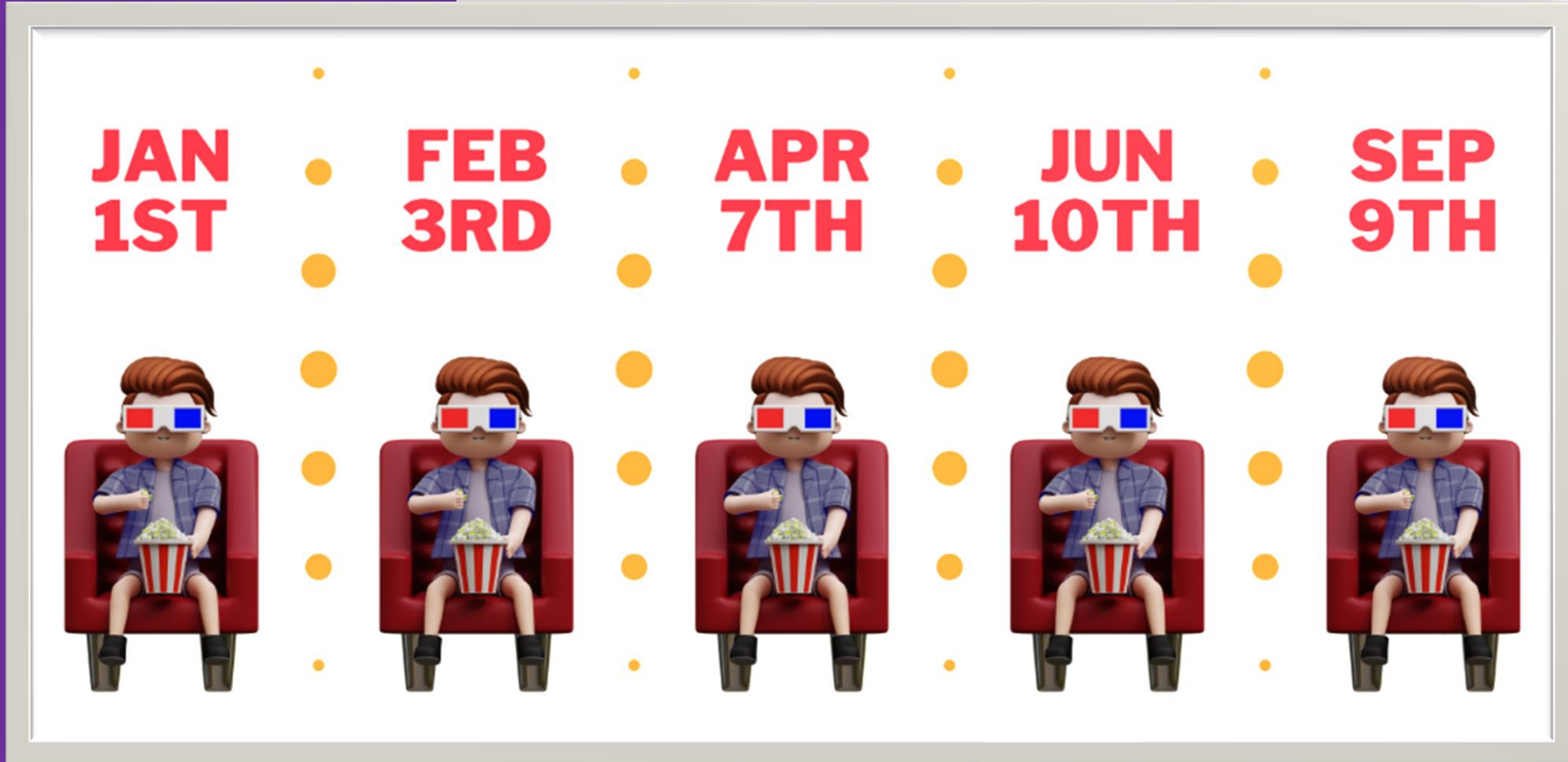
