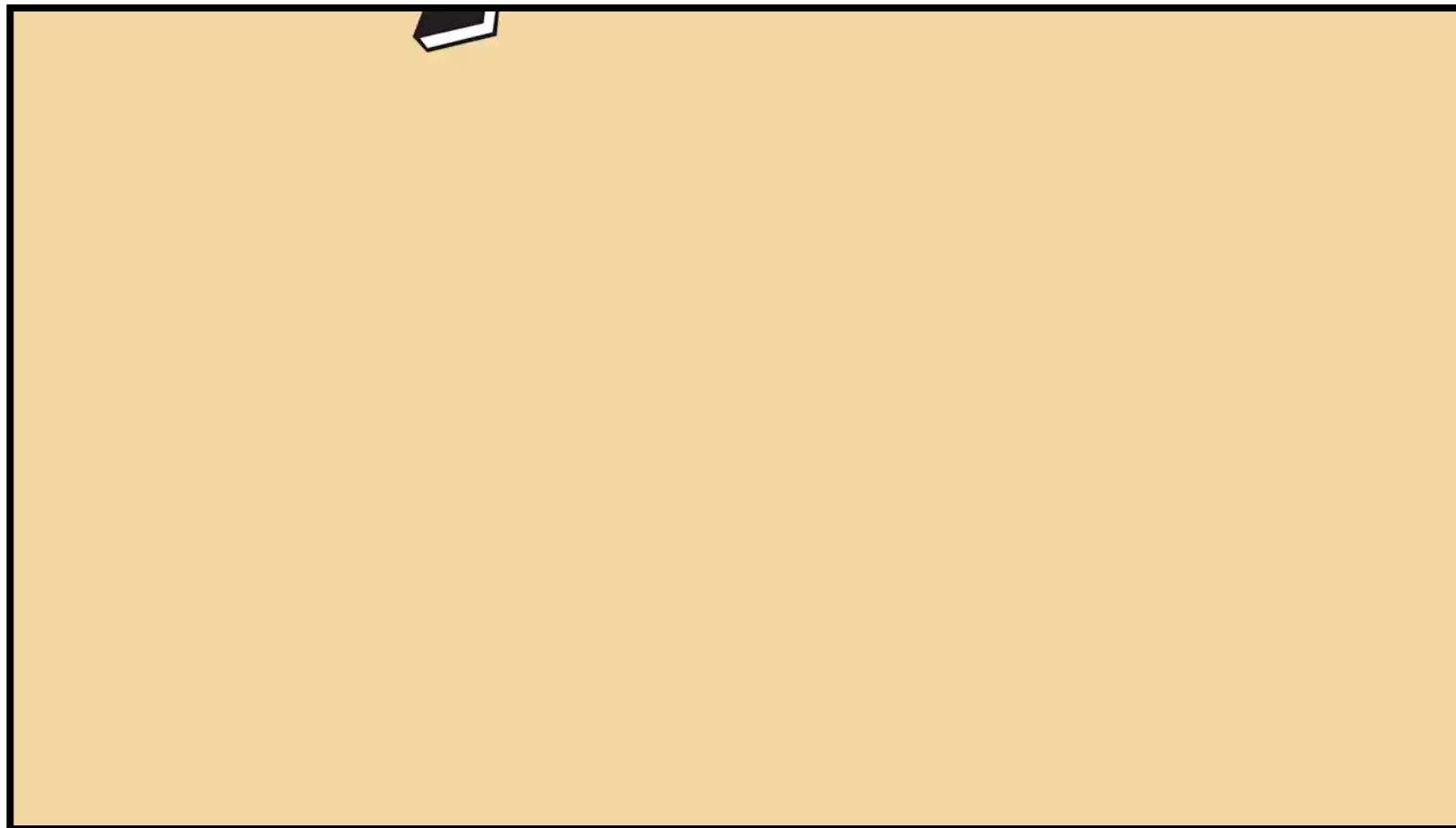




Present Continuous

WHEN TO USE?

Use the present continuous for actions happening **now**, around **now**, or planned for the future.

It also works for temporary situations and emphasizing annoying habits.

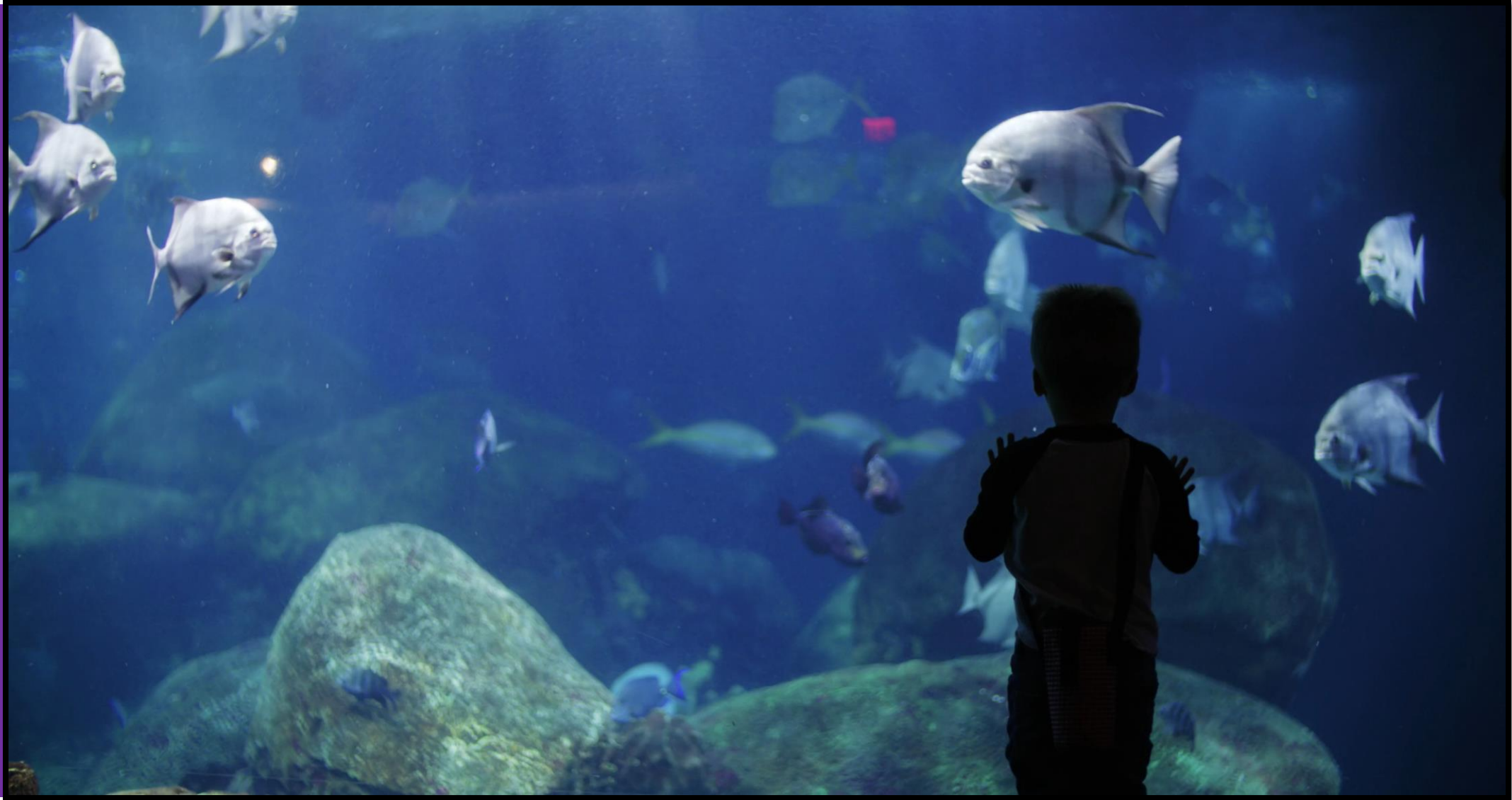


SENTENCE STRUCTURE

Subject + am/is/are + Verb (ing) + Object

I	am	running	at the moment
You	are	eating	lunch now
We	are	making	cars this year
They	are	typing	documents this week
He	is	teaching	lessons today
She	is	drinking	tea this evening
It	is	moving	its tail now
