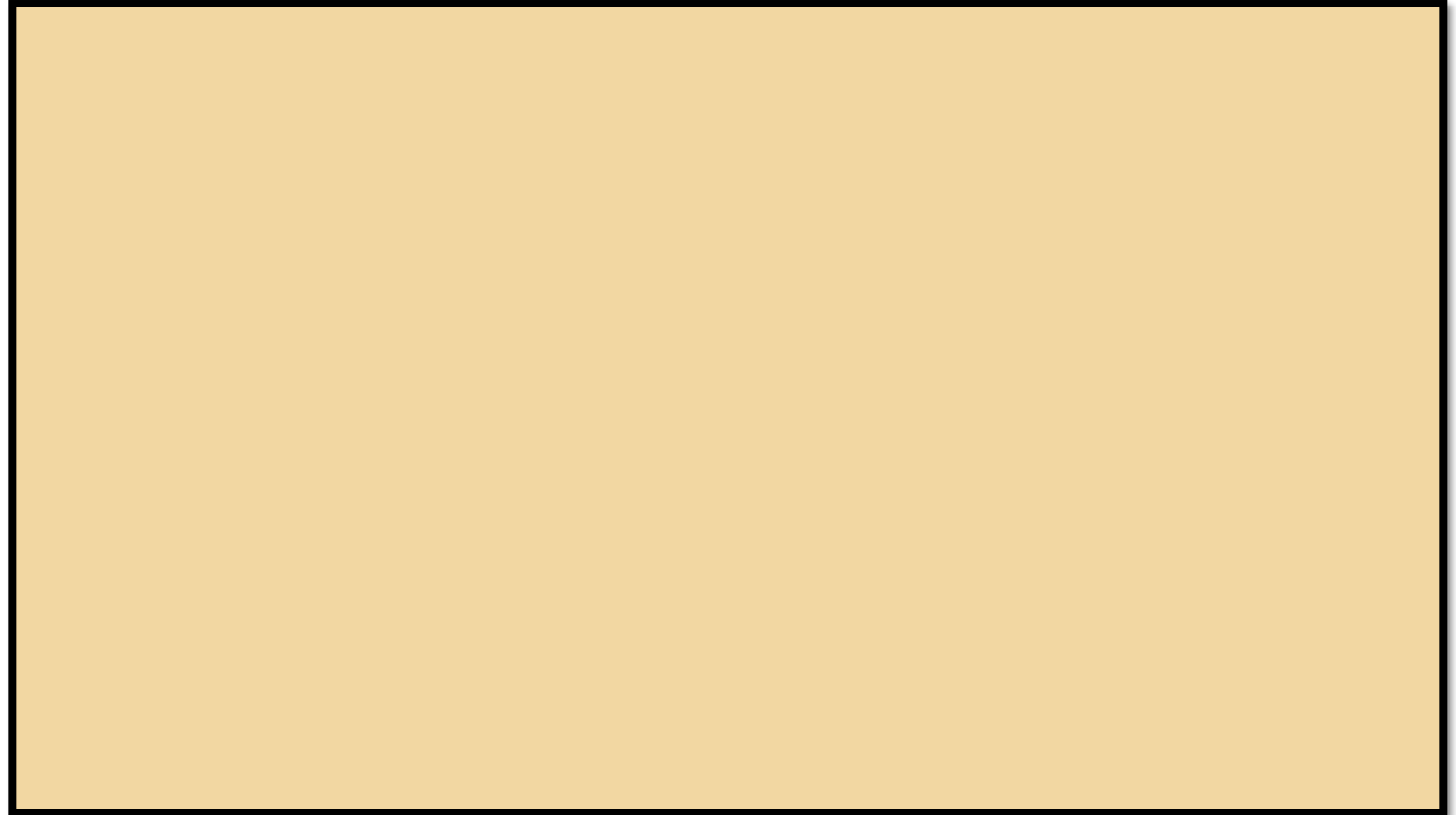

WHEN TO USE?

You use the simple past tense to talk about actions or states that were completed in the **past**, at a specific time or over a period of time.



SENTENCE STRUCTURE (Regular Verbs)

Subject	+	Verb (-ed)	+	Object
I		walked		yesterday
You		typed		a document last week
We		played		in our childhood
They		published		an article last month
He		painted		the house in 2022
She		loved		reading books
It		moved		So fast



SENTENCE STRUCTURE (Irregular Verbs)

Subject	+	Verb (past form)	+	Object
I		went		yesterday
You		ate		a salad last week
We		saw		the map on Google
They		ran		a marathon
He		wrote		a letter
She		became		an Engineer
It		caught		a fish this morning
