WHEN TO USE?

The simple future tense is used to talk about actions or events that will happen in the **future**.

It's formed by using the auxiliary verb "will" or "shall" (though "will" is more common in modern English) followed by the base form of the verb.



SENTENCE STRUCTURE

Subject + will + Verb + Object

I will work tomorrow

You will eat after sometime

We will watch next Friday

They will run next week

He will write his exams

She will cook soon

It will catch in a few minutes
