

## Dialogue Practice Worksheets: Shopping and Travel

Read the dialogues carefully. Practice roleplay in pairs or groups.

### SHOPPING DIALOGUES

#### Shopping 1: Buying Groceries

Customer: Good morning.

Shopkeeper: Good morning. How can I help you?

Customer: I want to buy some rice and vegetables.

Shopkeeper: How much rice do you need?

Customer: I need five kilos of rice.

Shopkeeper: Do you want white rice or brown rice?

Customer: I want white rice.

Shopkeeper: Anything else?

Customer: Yes. Please give me tomatoes and onions.

Shopkeeper: That will be three hundred rupees.

Customer: Here is the money. Thank you.

Shopkeeper: Thank you. Have a nice day.

#### Shopping 2: Buying Clothes

Customer: Excuse me.

Shopkeeper: Yes, how can I help you?

Customer: I am looking for a shirt.

Shopkeeper: What size do you need?

Customer: Medium size.

Shopkeeper: What colour do you like?

Customer: I like blue.

Shopkeeper: Try this one.

Customer: It fits well. How much is it?

Shopkeeper: It is six hundred rupees.

Customer: I will take it.

Shopkeeper: Please come to the counter.

### **Shopping 3: Buying a Book**

Customer: Hello.

Shopkeeper: Hello.

Customer: Do you have English storybooks for children?

Shopkeeper: Yes, we do.

Customer: Can I see them?

Shopkeeper: These are storybooks for Class 3.

Customer: This one looks good. How much does it cost?

Shopkeeper: It costs two hundred rupees.

Customer: Okay, I will buy it.

Shopkeeper: Thank you.

### **Shopping 4: At a Fruit Shop**

Customer: Hello.

Shopkeeper: Hello.

Customer: How much are the apples?

Shopkeeper: One hundred rupees per kilo.

Customer: Give me one kilo, please.

Shopkeeper: Would you like oranges also?

Customer: Yes, half a kilo.

Shopkeeper: The total is one hundred fifty rupees.

Customer: Here you go.

### **Shopping 5: Returning an Item**

Customer: Excuse me.

Shopkeeper: Yes?

Customer: I bought this bag yesterday.

Shopkeeper: Is there any problem?

Customer: Yes, the zip is broken.

Shopkeeper: I am sorry about that.

Customer: Can I change it?

Shopkeeper: Yes, you can choose another bag.

Customer: Thank you very much.

Shopkeeper: You're welcome.

## **TRAVEL DIALOGUES**

### **Travel 1: At the Bus Stop**

Passenger: Excuse me.

Person: Yes?

Passenger: Which bus goes to the city hospital?

Person: Bus number ten goes there.

Passenger: How often does the bus come?

Person: Every fifteen minutes.

Passenger: Thank you.

Person: You're welcome.

### **Travel 2: Buying a Train Ticket**

Passenger: Good morning.

Clerk: Good morning.

Passenger: I want one ticket to Chennai.

Clerk: When do you want to travel?

Passenger: Tomorrow morning.

Clerk: Sleeper or general ticket?

Passenger: Sleeper ticket, please.

Clerk: The fare is five hundred rupees.

Passenger: Here is the money.

Clerk: Here is your ticket.

### **Travel 3: Asking for Directions**

Traveller: Excuse me, can you help me?

Local Person: Yes, sure.

Traveller: How can I go to the railway station?

Local Person: Go straight and turn right.

Traveller: Is it far from here?

Local Person: No, it is ten minutes from here.

Traveller: Thank you very much.

Local Person: No problem.

### **Travel 4: At the Airport**

Passenger: Good afternoon.

Staff: Good afternoon. May I see your ticket?

Passenger: Yes, here it is.
