

## Dialogue Practice Worksheets: Text Messaging and Appointments

These dialogues are designed for deaf students. Practice reading, typing, and roleplay using text messages.

### TEXT MESSAGING – DIALOGUES

#### Text Message 1: Messaging a Friend

Anil: Hi Raju! How are you?

Raju: Hi Anil! I am fine.

Anil: Are you free this evening?

Raju: Yes, I am free.

Anil: Let us meet at the park.

Raju: Okay. See you there.

Anil: See you.

#### Text Message 2: Messaging a Teacher

Meena: Good evening, teacher.

Teacher: Good evening, Meena.

Meena: I have a doubt in my English homework.

Teacher: Which question?

Meena: Question number five.

Teacher: I will explain it tomorrow in class.

Meena: Thank you, teacher.

Teacher: You are welcome.

#### Text Message 3: Messaging a Shop

Customer: Hello. Is this the book shop?

Shop: Yes, this is the book shop.

Customer: Do you have English grammar books?

Shop: Yes, we have them.

Customer: What is the price?

Shop: It is two hundred rupees.

Customer: Thank you.

Shop: You are welcome.

#### **Text Message 4: Wrong Message**

Sender: Hello, is this Sita?

Receiver: Sorry, wrong number.

Sender: Oh, sorry for the trouble.

Receiver: No problem.

Sender: Thank you.

Receiver: Bye.

#### **Text Message 5: Leaving a Message**

Anu: Hi. Is Ravi available?

Mother: No, he is not at home.

Anu: Please tell him to message me.

Mother: Okay, I will tell him.

Anu: Thank you.

Mother: You are welcome.

### **FIXING APPOINTMENTS – DIALOGUES**

#### **Appointment 1: Doctor**

Patient: Good morning.

Receptionist: Good morning.

Patient: I want to fix an appointment with the doctor.

Receptionist: Which day do you want?

Patient: Tomorrow morning.

Receptionist: The doctor is free at 10 am.

Patient: That is fine.

Receptionist: Your appointment is fixed.

Patient: Thank you.

Receptionist: You are welcome.

### **Appointment 2: Teacher Meeting**

Parent: Good afternoon.

Teacher: Good afternoon.

Parent: I want to meet you.

Teacher: When do you want to meet?

Parent: Tomorrow after school.

Teacher: Okay, at 4 pm.

Parent: That is fine.

Teacher: See you tomorrow.

Parent: Thank you.

### **Appointment 3: Office Visit**

Visitor: Hello.

Office Staff: Hello.

Visitor: I want to fix a meeting.

Office Staff: Which day is good for you?

Visitor: Monday morning.

Office Staff: The meeting is at 11 am.

Visitor: Okay.

Office Staff: Please come on time.

Visitor: Sure, thank you.

### **Appointment 4: Haircut**

Customer: Hello.

Staff: Hello.

Customer: Can I get an appointment for a haircut?

Staff: Yes. When do you want?

Customer: This evening.

Staff: 6 pm is free.

Customer: That is fine.

Staff: Your appointment is booked.

Customer: Thank you.

#### **Appointment 5: Repair Service**

Customer: Hello.

Service Person: Hello.

Customer: My fan is not working.

Service Person: When can I come?

Customer: Tomorrow morning.

Service Person: Okay, at 9 am.

Customer: That is fine.

Service Person: See you tomorrow.

Customer: Thank you.
