

Roleplay Practice Worksheet

Read the situation and practice the roleplay with a partner.

Roleplay 1: Asking for Permission in School

Situation: A student wants to leave class early.

Roles: Teacher, Student

Student: Excuse me, teacher. May I leave the class early today?

Teacher: Why do you want to leave early?

Student: I have a doctor's appointment.

Teacher: Did you inform your parents?

Student: Yes, my parents know.

Teacher: Okay. You may leave after the class ends.

Student: Thank you, teacher.

Roleplay 2: Buying Items at a Shop

Situation: A student goes to buy a notebook.

Roles: Customer, Shopkeeper

Customer: Excuse me. Do you have notebooks?

Shopkeeper: Yes, we do. Which size do you want?

Customer: I want a big notebook.

Shopkeeper: It costs fifty rupees.

Customer: Okay. I will take one.

Shopkeeper: Here you go.

Customer: Thank you.

Roleplay 3: Helping a Classmate

Situation: A student does not understand homework.

Roles: Student A, Student B

Student A: I do not understand this maths question.

Student B: Let me see it.

Student A: Thank you.

Student B: First, add these numbers.

Student A: Oh, I understand now.

Student B: Good. Tell me if you need more help.

Roleplay 4: Fixing an Appointment

Situation: A student wants to meet the teacher after school.

Roles: Student, Teacher

Student: Good afternoon, teacher. Can I meet you after school?

Teacher: Yes. What is the reason?

Student: I need help with my project.

Teacher: Okay. Come at 4 pm.

Student: Thank you. I will come on time.

Teacher: You are welcome.

Roleplay 5: Planning a Group Activity

Situation: Students are planning a group project.

Roles: Student 1, Student 2, Student 3

Student 1: We need to choose a topic for our project.

Student 2: Let us choose saving water.

Student 3: That is a good idea.

Student 1: Who will make the charts?

Student 2: I will make the charts.

Student 3: I will collect pictures.

Student 1: Great. Let us finish it on time.
