

# Perfect Tenses – Example Sentences

---

## 1. Present Perfect (Past action → result now)

I have finished my homework.

She has cleaned the room.

They have completed the project.

I have lost my wallet.

He has broken his phone.

We have watched that movie.

She has written a letter.

I have eaten breakfast.

They have opened the shop.

He has found his keys.

## 2. Present Perfect Continuous (Started in past → still continuing)

I have been studying for two hours.

She has been working since morning.

They have been playing cricket.

He has been reading a book.

We have been waiting for the bus.

I have been learning English.

She has been cooking for an hour.

They have been talking for a long time.

He has been running in the park.

We have been practicing daily.

### **3. Past Perfect (Past before past)**

I had finished my work before dinner.

She had left before I arrived.

They had completed the task earlier.

He had eaten before the meeting started.

We had booked the tickets in advance.

I had seen that movie before.

She had written the exam already.

They had closed the shop before rain started.

He had learned English in school.

We had met him earlier.

### **4. Past Perfect Continuous (Duration before past)**

I had been studying for two hours before the exam.

She had been working all day before she rested.

They had been playing before it started raining.

He had been reading for a long time before sleeping.

We had been waiting for an hour before the bus came.

I had been learning English before I got the job.

She had been cooking before the guests arrived.

They had been talking before the teacher came.

He had been running before he felt tired.

We had been practicing before the competition.

### **5. Future Perfect (Completed before future)**

I will have finished my homework by evening.

She will have completed the course by next month.

They will have reached home by 8 PM.

He will have written the report by tomorrow.

We will have cleaned the house by evening.

I will have learned this lesson by tomorrow.

She will have prepared dinner by 7 PM.

They will have completed the project soon.

He will have fixed the problem by then.

We will have watched the movie by night.

## **6. Future Perfect Continuous (Duration until future)**

I will have been studying for three hours by evening.

She will have been working all day by night.

They will have been playing for two hours by lunch.

He will have been reading for a long time by then.

We will have been waiting for an hour by 6 PM.

I will have been learning English for a year by December.

She will have been cooking for two hours by dinner time.

They will have been traveling for a day by tomorrow.

He will have been running for an hour by morning.

We will have been practicing for weeks by the event.
