

Conditionals – Example Sentences

1. Zero Conditional (Always true / general facts)

If you heat water, it boils.

If you mix red and blue, you get purple.

If it rains, the ground gets wet.

If you don't eat, you feel weak.

If you touch fire, you get burned.

If the sun sets, it becomes dark.

If you freeze water, it turns into ice.

If plants don't get water, they die.

If you study regularly, you learn better.

If you press this button, the machine starts.

2. First Conditional (Real possibility – future)

If I study, I will pass the exam.

If it rains, we will stay at home.

If you call me, I will answer.

If she works hard, she will succeed.

If they come early, we will start the meeting.

If you don't hurry, you will miss the bus.

If he practices daily, he will improve.

If we save money, we will buy a bike.

If you help me, I will finish quickly.

If she invites me, I will go.

3. Second Conditional (Unreal / imaginary)

If I were rich, I would travel the world.

If I had a car, I would drive to work.

If she studied more, she would pass.

If I were you, I would take that job.

If they lived nearby, we would meet often.

If I had more time, I would learn guitar.

If he knew the answer, he would tell you.

If we had a bigger house, we would invite guests.

If she spoke English well, she would get the job.

If I were a bird, I would fly.

4. Third Conditional (Unreal past / regret)

If I had studied, I would have passed the exam.

If she had left early, she would have caught the bus.

If they had worked harder, they would have succeeded.

If I had known the truth, I would have told you.

If he had practiced, he would have won.

If we had saved money, we would have bought a house.

If she had listened to me, she would have avoided the mistake.

If they had invited me, I would have gone.

If I had woken up early, I would have reached on time.

If he had taken the job, he would have been happy.

5. Mixed Conditionals (Past affects present)

If I had studied, I would be successful now.

If she had worked harder, she would have a better job today.

If they had saved money, they would be rich now.

If I had learned English earlier, I would speak confidently now.

If he had trained well, he would be a champion now.

If we had started earlier, we would be finished now.

If she had taken that course, she would be working now.

If I had followed your advice, I would be happy now.

If they had invested money, they would be earning now.

If he had not wasted time, he would be successful now.
