2. Statements (told + person + that)

3. Yes/No Questions (asked + if/whether)

They asked if I would help them.

I asked if he had seen that place.

She asked whether we were busy.

He asked whether I could come early.

4. WH Questions (asked + WH word)

She asked where I was going.

He asked what I was doing.

They asked when we would arrive.

I asked why she was late.

She asked how he had done that.

He asked who I was talking to.

They asked which book I liked.

I asked where they had gone.

She asked why I was upset.

He asked how I would solve the problem.

5. Commands (told + person + to)

She told me to open the door.

He told me to sit down.

They told us to wait outside.

I told him to finish the work.

She told him to call her.

He told them to be quiet.

They told me to bring the book.

I told her to clean the room.

She told us to follow the rules.

He told me to come early.

6. Requests (asked + person + to)

She asked me to help her.

He asked me to open the window.

They asked us to wait for them.

I asked her to explain the answer.

She asked him to call her later.

He asked them to join the meeting.

They asked me to bring a pen.

I asked him to check my work.

She asked us to come early.

He asked me to close the door.
